On 5/19/87, [redacted] the MICHIGAN REGIONAL OFFICE OF THE ANTI DEFAMATION LEAGUE OF BNAI BRITH, 4000 Town Center, Suite 420, Southfield, Michigan, telephone number [redacted] provided a letter that was received by his office on Thursday, 5/11/87. The envelope containing the letter was postmarked "Manchester, New Hampshire," and dated "7 May, 1987."

The letter itself was addressed to [redacted] and threatened his life. Furthermore, the envelope was improperly addressed to the old address of the ADL at 163 Madison Avenue, Suite 120, Detroit, Michigan.

It is recommended that a 9A-New case be initiated.




This letter is to confirm the conversation between Assistant United States Attorney (AUSA) [Redacted] and Special Agent (SA) [Redacted] on June 16, 1987, in which the following matter was discussed:

On May 19, 1987, [Redacted] Michigan Regional Office of the Anti Defamation League of B'nai B'rith, 4000 Town Center, Suite 420, Southfield, Michigan, provided to the FBI a letter which was received at his office on Thursday, May 11, 1987. [Redacted] advised that the letter was postmarked Manchester, New Hampshire and dated May 7, 1987. [Redacted] further advised that the letter was not in fact addressed to the proper address for the Anti Defamation League and that the regional office of the Anti Defamation League has not been located in the city of Detroit for some time. [Redacted] said that the post office forwarded letter after it was received at the improper address.
